**Early Voting: Jul. 12 – Jul. 27
Early Voting Site: 157 Western Plaza, Newport
Absentee Ballot Request Period: May 3 – Jul. 25
Voter Registration Deadline: Jul. 2**

There is a Primary Election on August 1.
If the voter wishes to vote in the Federal and State Primary, then the voter must declare Republican or Democratic when appearing to vote in-person or when requesting a by-mail ballot. Each voter will receive the same County General Election ballot specific to their county district regardless of whether the voter participates in a party primary.

Absentee Ballot Request Period: Aug. 7 – Oct. 29
Voter Registration Deadline: Oct. 7**

This is a General Election.
The voter does not declare a party preference during the November 5 General Election.
